1. Treating Patients and Training the Local Medical staff in cooperation with Italian organizations

During the year 2021, Heevie organization continues the activities of one of its important projects aiming to provide treatment opportunities for patients suffering from difficult and difficult to cure diseases, which is through a regular program implemented in cooperation with Italian partners involving hospitals, advanced medical centers and the Italian organizations. Through this project, Heevie provides the necessary medical support and treatment opportunities for children with various diseases and deformities, which is done either through surgical interventions or through the other treatment methods. The diseases that were treated included congenital heart diseases and malformations, kidney and reproductive system malformations, tumors and malignant diseases, blood diseases and others.

Since the beginning of the program, hundreds of children with various medical and surgical problems have been sent to Italy for medical and surgical treatment, which was done with the support of the Kurdistan Regional Government and in coordination with Italian partners. When the infrastructure of the local health centers became ready to support the activities of the program, the specialized Italian teams began to visit the Kurdistan Region of Iraq according to a regular schedule, at a rate of 4 missions per year, during these visits more than 200 operations were carried out during one year (an average of 50 operations per each visit).

During their regular visits to the region, the existence of the specialized Italian teams was utilized to involve the local staff in all phases of the program and treatment as part of training and capacity building. This included training on preparing the patients for surgeries, post-operative follow-up and care, intensive care unit work, managing complications and performing different medical and surgical operations. The program also included training doctors on echocardiogram in the Italian hospitals.

After a program was stopped in the previous years as a result of the situation in the region, Heevie organization is working to resume the program in cooperation with the Italian partners and the local government. This will be done in coordination with Cuore Fratello Onlus from Italy aiming to establish the management opportunities for the children with congenital heart anomalies. During the year 2021, and part of the project, (7) children suffering from congenital heart diseases were sent to Italy to undergo surgery and receive the necessary treatment.

2. Project: Registering and examining the Congenital Heart Diseases Children in Kurdistan Region

During the year 2021, Heevie Orgaization continued working on its program of documenting the details and information of the patients with congenital heart defects, in an effort to make them ready and available when any treatment or surgical intervention opportunity is available. This activity is implemented in cooperation with SIA Italian organization, through which an integrated database was created for patients with congenital heart defects in Kurdistan Region and Iraq, and it had a significant impact on the health status of the patients, their living conditions and their chances of obtaining treatment. During the year 2021, Heevie registered (353) new cases of children with congenital heart disease in its database.

3.Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Mam Rash IDP camp in Ninawa governorate.

For the sixth successive year, Heevie organization continued to provide health care services to the residents of Mam Rash IDPs camp in Sheikhan district of Ninewa governorate, through its health center in the camp. The camp hosts more than 10,000 people, and the activities implemented by Heevie organization in the camp represent a complete response to the needs of its residents at the primary health care level, involving treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases, reproductive health care services, health awareness, psychosocial support, growth monitoring, vaccination and disease surveillance and control, added to the to services on the secondary-level services such as ultrasound examination, oral and dental health and specialized medical laboratory examinations, all free of charge. The project is being implemented with the support of the World Health Organization, and the number of patients who received treatment inside Heevie health center in Mam Rash camp during the year 2021 has reached (32,648) patients.

4.Project: Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Shariya IDP camp in Ninawa governorate

Shariya camp is considered among the largest camps in terms of area and population density in Dohuk governorate, with a capacity to host around 18,000 people. The camp has been established since 2014, with the start of the huge waves of displacement of the population to Dohuk governorate, especially from Sinjar district. In continuation of its programs to serve the IDPs in Dohuk governorate, Heevie organization is running the primary health care center in Shariya camp, doing a remarkable improvement in the services, as the services provided include the full package of primary health care services in addition to some services at the secondary level such as the ultrasound examination, oral and dental hygiene, and the medical laboratory examinations. The health staff working within Heevie PHC in the camp includes different specializations, who have been recruited in order to respond as much as possible to all the needs of the population, this included internal medicine, pediatrics, general surgery and gynecological specialities. This specific step had the greatest impact in reducing referrals to higher health levels and thus reduced the burden on those facilities and also decreased the economic, psychological and social impact of the residents of the camp. The project is being implemented with the support of World Health Organization, and the number of patients who received treatment during the year 2021 in Heevie PHC at Shariya camp reached about (43,303) patients.

5. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Bersivy1 IDP camp in Duhok governorate

Among the camps that Heevie organization covers with health activities is Bersivy1 IDPs camp in Zakho district, which hosts thousands of families who were displaced from Sinjar district early during the war against the ISIS terroristic group in 2014. The camp has a capacity of hosting about 11,000 people, and Heevie provides the full package of primary health care services, in addition to ultrasound examination, oral and dental health services, and advanced laboratory services, some of which are considered among the services provided at the secondary level. The services provided are the curative services, preventive services, psychosocial support services, health education, growth monitoring, reproductive health care services and vaccinations. Heevie PHC in the camp is active 24 hourly, 7 days a week, with the aim of responding to the maximum needs of the camp residents. The project activities were implemented in the first nine months of the year 2021 with the support of the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UNOCHA), while the last three months of the year were implemented with the support of the World Health Organization (WHO).

During the past year 2021, (30,689) patients were examined and treated through Heevie Health Center in Bersivy1 Camp, who were distributed over the months as shown in the table below.

6. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Kabarto2 IDP camp in Duhok governorate

Kabarto2 IDPs camp in Semeel district, Dohuk governorate, hosting about 13,000 people, is one of the camps that got benefit from the health services provided by Heevie Organization for the IDPs in the various camps, which is done through the Heevie health center in the aforementioned camp. The services that are provided include the treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases, reproductive healthcare services, nutrition, vaccinations, health awareness, psychosocial support, laboratory, dental services and ultrasound examination. Heevie project played an important role in alleviating the burden on the IDPs living in Kabarto2 camp, through providing advanced services, in addition to the full package of primary health care services provided.

This project is being implemented with the support of the World Health Organization, the number of patients who received treatment during the year 2021 in Heevie PHC at Kabarto2 camp reached about (36,437) patients.

7.Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Hasan Sham U2 IDP camp in Ninawa governorate

The health services provided by Heevie organization covered the needed of the affected population in multiple locations in different governorates, including Erbil governorate, which hosts large numbers of IDPs and refugees distributed in different camps, including Hassan Sham U2 IDPs camp in Khazir region and has the capacity of hosting around 9,000 people, where Heevie PHC is active to provide the primary health care services to the camp residents who are mainly from Mosul city and its surroundings and were displaced during the military operations to liberate their areas.

The healthcare services are provided by an experienced medical staff cover 24 hourly time period, and include medical consultations, treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases, treatment of chronic diseases, reproductive health care services and medical laboratory services, in addition to nutritional services and vaccinations that are provided in coordination with the Directorate of Health in Erbil Governorate.

Heevie Organization project in the camp continues with the support of the World Health Organization, and the total number of patients who got benefit from the services provided inside the PHC in Hassan Sham camp during the year 2021 reached about (22,704) patients, as shown in the table below:

8.Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Ashti IDP camp in Sulaymaniyah governorate

Ashti camp, located in the Arbat subdistrict of Sulaymaniyah governorate, is inhabited by thousands of displaced people fleeing the conditions of wars and crises that have spread in various regions of Iraq during the last few years, especially with the period of ISIS control over some areas and the subsequent wars against this terrorist group. As part of responding to the needs of the residents of Ashti camp, Heevie organization provides primary health care services through its health center in the camp, which includes the treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases as well as antenatal care services, nutrition, vaccinations, laboratory tests, education and health education Psychosocial support and ultrasound.

During the year 2021, the total number of medical consultations inside the health center of Heevie organization in Ashti camp reached (37,706) patients.

9. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Rwanga IDP camp in Duhok governorate

Among the various camps in Dohuk governorate, which were established since the beginning of the displacement crisis during the war against ISIS terroristic group, is the Rwanga (Qadia) IDPs camp, that hosts thousands of displaced people fleeing the scourge of wars and disasters that followed ISIS occupation of large areas of Ninewa Governorate, and a number of other provinces in Iraq.

Heevie organization provides and responds to the health needs of Rwanga camp through its primary health care center, which is active around the clock and is equipped with a specialized and trained staff to provide health services. The services provided include curative and preventive services, psychosocial support services, health education, growth monitoring, health Reproductive, insemination and laboratory.

10. Project: Heevie project to provide health care services in Bozan sub district within Talkaif district

Heevie organization continued its support for the health system and health facilities in the liberated areas, including those affected by the war against ISIS, as well as from the long-term neglect. During the year 2021, Heevie organization supported health centers in several areas of Ninewa Governorate, including the primary care center of Bouzan Subdistrict in Talkaif district, providing it with the necessary medical staff of doctors and nurses, as well as providing medicines and medical supplies with daily work supplies. The project consists of the activities listed below:

1. Treating the patients by specialist doctors
2. Reproductive health services
3. Health services for children, especially children under five years of age
4. Providing medications
5. Implementation of health awareness and education programs
6. Referral of patients to the higher health care services

This project is implemented by Heevie organization in cooperation with Farmamundi Spanish organization and with the support of the Spanish Agency for International Development Cooperation (AECID). The project started in mid-February 2021, and the number of patients who received treatment within the center was about (6,751) patients.

11. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie/Farmamundi specialized health center at Cham Mishko IDP camp in Duhok governorate.

In a continuation of the efforts made to provide the best healthcare services to the displaced inside the camps, and in the framework of the constant quest to fill the gaps in these services in various locations, Heevie organization, in cooperation with Farmamundi Spanish organization, started a project to provide quality health care services in Chameshku camp for the displaced in Zakho District, Dohuk Governorate. The camp is considered the largest one in Dohuk governorate, with a capacity of about 26,000 population. The health services are provided within a specialized medical center that was built by Heevie engineering department with a joint support from Heevie and Farmamundi.

The center started providing the planned health services on May 1st 2021, which is done by the support of the Spanish Agency for International Development Cooperation AECID. The total number of patients who received treatment during the past year reached (29,159) patients

Despite that more than six years have already passed since the displacement of hundred thousands population from the various Iraqi governorates, still many of those IDPs are unable to return back to their original places due to several reasons, from those are the displaced people living in various camps throughout Dohuk governorate, who are mostly from Sinjar district of Ninewa governorate and the surrounding regions. In this regard, sustaining the provision of the basic life support services and providing the basic needs for those population is one of the most important issues that must be focused on in the coming period, and which needs the efforts of all parties to ensure its achievement.

As part of its attempts to provide the healthcare services to the camp populations, Heevie organization started its project to provide the primary health care services to the residents of Essian camp, through Heevie health center in the camp. The project started on November 1st with the support of the World Health Organization. Essian camp is located in Sheikhan district and is inhabited by about 13,000 people. During 2021, the total number of patients treated and managed within the healthcare center in the camp reached **(4,917)** patients.

Bajed Kandala1 camp is located in Semel district and is inhabited, with the residents of Bajid Kandala2 camp, by about 8,000 people.

During 2021, the total number of patients examined and treated in the camp PHC reached **(1,914)** patients.

14. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Bersivy2 IDP camp in Duhok governorate

According to statistics and figures issued by the Joint Crises Coordination Center in Dohuk governorate, and until the beginning of December 2021, the total number of IDPs in Dohuk governorate reached 330,531 people, from whom 135,047 are habiting 16 camps. Despite that seven years have passed since the big waves of displacement from several governorates in Iraq, including those of Ninewa Governorate, many of these IDPs have not been able to return back to their original areas, from whom are the IDPs habiting Dohuk Governorate, who are mainly from Sinjar district.

In its quest to provide the healthcare services in IDP camps, Heevie organization started its project to provide primary health care services in Bersivy2 IDPs camp for the in Zakho district, which is inhabited by more than 7,100 people, through Heevie PHCC in the camp.

The project started on November 1st 2021 and is implemented with the support of the World Health Organization. During 2021, the total number of consultations within Heevie health facility in Bersivy2 camp reached **(3,077)** patients.

15. Project: Providing the Physical Rehabilitation Services for IDPs in Duhok governorate

The health services provided by Heevie organization are covering the all the healthcare levels, from primary to secondary and advanced health care levels. Among these services are the physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation services, which Heevie provides within a specialized center established by the organization specifically for this purpose and has provided it with a specialized staff of doctors, physiotherapists, nurses and other staff. Heevie Physiotherapy and Medical Rehabilitation Center involves the following departments:

- Registration and data Department
- Medical Consultation Unit
- Physical rehabilitation halls
- Massage and Laser Therapy
- Dressing room
- Administration and management
- Maintenance

The center provides its services to the IDPs, refugees and the host community population, and in an attempt to facilitate the transfer of beneficiaries from the camps to the center, Heevie has allocated transportation means from several camps to move the patients to the center according to fixed schedules, in addition, a special vehicle has been provided to transport the bed-ridden patients. The center also provided (161) supportive devices for people with special needs, such as wheelchairs, crutches, sticks and other supportive devices.

The total number of patients who benefited from the services provided at the Heevie Center for Physiotherapy and Medical Rehabilitation during the year 2021 (9,414) reached patients, as shown in the table below

16. Project: Providing access to the mental and psychosocial support services for the vulnerable populations in Erbil governorate

In an attempt to fill the apparent gaps in regard to the provision of mental health and psychosocial support services in the IDPs camps in the different governorates, Heevie organization, with the support of World Health Organization, is implementing a comprehensive project aimed at providing the mental health, the psychological and social support. This project included the provision of MHPSS services in eight camps for the displaced, distributed over Dohuk, Erbil and Ninewa governorates. Among the locations covered in Erbil governorate are Debaga camp and Kalak sub-district, where Heevie organization is running two mental health and psychological support centers equipped with specialized staff from psychiatrists doctors, pshychologists and social workers.

The project includes providing the necessary interventional procedures to address mental, psychological and social health problems for patients through well-trained staff, targeting the different age groups of IDPs, refugees and host community population benefit. The treatment provided includes psychotherapy sessions, as well as drug and medical treatment for any case may be in need of it.

17. Project: Providing access to the mental and psychosocial support services for the vulnerable populations in Duhok governorate

During the year 2021, Heevie organization started its new project to provide the mental health and psychological support services in the camps of the displaced through specialized centers. This was done after taking into account the high numbers of mental health cases and the increasing numbers of suicide in the camps, making the availability of specialized centers to provide the necessary support in this regard one of the basic requirements for any health intervention program targeting the IDPs and the other vulnerable population.

In order to provide the mental health services in an optimal way, these centers are provided with a specialized staff of psychiatrist's doctors, psychologists and social workers, from both genders. The centers operate and provide services six days per week on a regular basis and the service delivery time has been modified to be for noon and evening hours, from 1:00 to 6:00 pm, allowing sufficient privacy for patients, and on the other hand permits for a total allocation of facilities to the MHPSS activities.

The duties and responsibilities of the project staff are organized in a way allowing for a smooth work flow and for more effective case detection and management. As part of this process, the social workers perform tent-to-tent visits, they visit community and social centers and schools in the camp in order to pick up the suspected cases and then refer them to the MHPSS centers, where they are received by psychotherapists who organize and sort them to choose the cases that need the intervention of the specialist psychiatrists doctor. The treatment provided within these centers includes both psychotherapy sessions and medication therapy.

Heevie project of mental health services and psychosocial support includes six camps, which are Shariya, Kabarto2, Rwanga, Bersivy1, Mam Rash and Chameshku. During the year 2021, the total number of mental health consultations within these centers reached (6861) Consultations. Below is a table with the breakdown of the cases according to the gender and age.

18. Project: Supporting the local health system in Talafar and Sinjar districts of Ninewa governorate

During 2021, Heevie organization started a promising project in Ninewa Governorate, and more specifically in Sinjar and Talafar districts, which were of the districts greatly affected by the occupation of ISIS, and are recovering from conflicts and crisis that have affected the general aspects of the lives of millions of people in these areas, exposing thousands of them to long-term physical and psychological damage. The destruction of the infrastructure, disruption of basic life support services systems, population displacement, and other negative matters, has made the entire picture of the tragic situation in many regions recovering from the occupation and wars.

Heevie project to support the health systems in the districts of Talafar and Sinjar includes the following activities:

1. Capacity building of the medical staff working in health facilities in the two districts
2. Providing the necessary medications and medical supplies according to the needs and the gaps
3. Supporting health centers in six sub-districts within Sinjar District, which are Al Aroba, Al Qadisiya, Golat, Hardan, Hitteen and Sharf Aldeen sub-districts

The project is being implemented with the support of the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), and it started on February 1st, 2021 and will continue for 12 months. The total number of medical consultations within the project during the project duration from the year 2021 reached (6,010) consultations, while (2,111) from the local medical staff on various medical topics were trained.

19. Project: Reproductive Health Care Services

As part of the attention paid to the women's health within its projects, specifically pregnant women and those of childbearing age, Heevie organization provides reproductive health services in all its health centers on a regular basis and through an efficient staff from doctors and nurses. These services include prenatal care, postnatal care and family planning services, and extends to include also the screening for breast cancer, education and promotion on breastfeeding as well as the provision of necessary medications and drugs. In order to provide the necessary tools for making the program successful, Heevie dedicated part of the support provided for the laboratory and pharmacy departments for the purpose of providing the necessary tests and medications for the the patients got benefit from the program, added to the ultrasound examination, which were of paramount importance for pregnant women and at all stages of pregnancy.

The project has been implemented with a direct support of Heevie organization in many centers, and also in cooperation with other partners in some of them. The following are the statistics of reproductive health care services provided within Heevie projects during the year 2021

20. Project: Psychosocial support services within Heevie projects In Camps (Shariya, Mam rash, Bersivy 1, Kabarto2, Rwanga , Cham Mishko , Ashti , Bajid Kadala , Bersivy2 and Essian Camp)

As part of the full package of health care services provided by Heevie, the psychosocial support and mental health care services are among the core services that the organization has engaged in its plan to respond to the health needs and requirements of the crises-affected population. The organization has given the necessary attention to this issue in order to fill the gap in this regard. In addition to managing the specialized centers in this field, Heevie has incorporated these services into all the primary health care centers it runs in the various camps.

Heevie provides the psychosocial support services to the beneficiaries through well-trained staff of doctors, psychologists and social workers in all the locations. The treatment provided includes individual and group psychotherapy sessions, as well as medications that are allowed to be given at this level, in addition to this, a referral service to secondary and specialized centers. The number of cases that received psychosocial support services within Heevie projects during the year 2021 reached (2,443) cases, as shown below:

21. Project: Health promotion/ education within Heevie projects In Camps (Shariya, Mam rash, Bersivy1, Kabarto2, Ashti, Rwanga, Cham Mishko, Bajid Kadala, Essian, and Bersivy2) and Bozan sub district

The health education and promotion activities have become an important element in health care programs, due to their great importance in the preventive and curative fields, and this importance has increased with the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, and with the increasing risks on the individual and public health as a result of the suspected epidemics of the communicable diseases, especially during the war and crisis. The importance of health awareness programs extends to integrating into the daily life of every person, whether suffering from a disease or not.

Heevie organization provides integrated programs for the health awareness and education, as this is done through daily activities that are implemented by community health workers in a scientific manner according to pre-established schedules. The duties of the community health workers are in three areas:

- Providing the health awareness sessions to visitors to health centers directly, whether through individual or group sessions
- Tent-to-tent and household visits to deliver health messages to the beneficiaries, informing them of the services in the health center, and also referring the cases that need specific services to the health center.
- Coordination and visits to community centers and schools to deliver the health messages

During the year 2021, the total number of health promotion sessions conducted within the projects of Heevie organization reached (12,186) session, and the number of people who attended those sessions reached (66,054) people, these numbers were distributed as in the table below:

22. Rising awareness to prevent and mitigate the transmission of COVID-19 among the vulnerable communities in 6 IDPs camps in Duhok and Sulaymaniyah governorates

As part of its activities to confront the Covid-19 pandemic, Heevie organization has implemented an expanded health awareness project in six IDPs camps in Dohuk and Sulaymaniyah governorates, which are Shariya, Kabarto2, Rwanga, Bersivy1 and Mam Rash in Duhok and Ashti in Sulaymaniyah. The project included practical steps to face COVID-19 pandemic involving increasing awareness about the disease in order to reduce the undesirable consequences of the disease and its complications.

The project focused also on training the health staff on awareness activities, spreading health awareness messages, distributing health protection materials such as medical masks, sterilization materials and gloves, in addition to distributing awareness leaflets and posters related to fighting COVID-19 pandemic. One of the other important objectives of the project was to encourage people to take Covid-19 vaccine while registering the names of those who wish to take the vaccine within the online vaccination system and helping them to reach the vaccination centers. The importance of the project comes from the point that the communication with people and their participation in various issues plays a vital role in disseminating transparent and reliable information on all medical and health topics, and also in responding to questions and rumors and containing fear among the population. The project lasted for two months with the support of the World Health Organization and was implemented between May and July 2021, below is a summary of the project's data and achievements

23. Establishing a Specialized Center for Treating and Isolating the COVID-19 Patients in Khabat District Erbil Governorate

As a part of Heevie projects and activities to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic and to provide the best management and treatment methods for the patients, Heevie Organization, in coordination with the World Health Organization and the Directorate of Health in Erbil governorate, has established a specialized center for treating and isolating the COVID-19 patients in Khabat district of Erbil Governorate. The center includes 14 patient admission wards with single or two beds maximum, with a total of more than 20 beds, each bed equipped with all necessary equipment with a central oxygen system. The center is also provided with pharmacy and laboratory departments in addition to special rooms for dressing, staff rest and exchange.

The project is implemented directly by Heevie engineering department with the support of the World Health Organization.

24. Establishing a specialized center for treating the pediatrics oncological diseases in Duhok Governorate

As a continuation of its efforts to support the local health system and as a part of its various engineering projects, Heevie Organization has started its project to establish (Galavezh) specialized center Pediatrics Oncological diseases in Dohuk governorate. The new center is being established within the geographical area of the Heevi Pediatrics Teaching Hospital and all its designs and maps have been developed by the engineering department of Heevie organization after consultation with the relevant and specialized authorities, also, all the special needs of the patients suffering from malignancies and oncological diseases are taken into consideration in terms of allocating special isolation rooms and single and double-bed wards, as well as units for the daily treatment and drug administration, inpatient wards, unit for preparation of treatment, and a pharmacy, in addition to allocating a special unit for taking the diagnostic samples from patients, equipped with the necessary tools and devices. To be mentioned, that the new extension of Heevi pediatrics hospital will involve also establishing a special Endoscopy unit at the hospital which will be equipped a prepared according the standards.

The center will be built according to the latest medical engineering systems, taking into account adopting the highest quality materials and tools. It is hoped that the new center will play an important role in improving the services provided to children suffering from oncological and malignancies, as they are currently being treated in a building that lacks many of the basic requirements for treating such kinds of diseases.

25. Project: Health Capacity Building

From its establishment until now, Heevie organization has paid a great and special attention to supporting the health institutions and developing the capabilities of health staff in all fields. This was done through formal frameworks represented in long-term cooperation agreements signed between Heevie and the Kurdistan Regional Government, as well as with the Ministry of Health and the health directorates in the different governorates. These agreements often included twinning with Italian organizations, hospitals and specialized medical centers in Italy.

Within this project, and in an attempt to fill the gaps in the capacity building activities in the region, Heevie, and in coordination with SIA Italian organization, is supporting the General Directorate of Health in Dohuk Governorate in a long-term program to maintain the necessary human resources and improve their scientific and professional levels to provide high-quality health care services in various facilities, hospitals and specialized centers under the Directorate. The activities of this project come after the Heevie teams conducted the required assessments to determine the shortages and needs in the various health facilities belonging to the Directorate of Health in Dohuk. This project of Heevie Organization aims to improve the skills and capabilities of health workers, as well as develop and improve intervention mechanisms, treatment methods and management modalities in various health facilities according to the following mechanisms:

- 1- Training and capacity building for health care service providers from various medical branches and specialties, either here locally in Italian hospitals
- 2- Filling the gaps related to the shortage of the staff in health facilities, which will be done in coordination with the Health Directorate through multiple mechanisms to respond to the increasing needs, especially within the newly established facilities.
- 3- Special missions and visits by Italian medical delegations and teams to health facilities in the region for the purpose of treating patients, as well as training the local health staff

The project activities during the year 2021 included the activities mentioned below:

1. Supporting the staff of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit at Heevi Pediatric Teaching Hospital
2. Supporting the staff of the cardiac and intensive care departments at Azadi Teaching Hospital.
3. Supporting the staff of Dohuk emergency surgical hospital.
4. Training courses for local medical staff in various fields.

The total number of cadres that were supported/trained during the year 2021 reached (55) people.

Other Activities in 2021

1. COVID-19 Awareness and prevention activities

Along with the current situation in the region regarding the risk of Covid-19 infection and due to the important role of protection systems in preventing this highly contagious disease, Heevie organization has started implementing strict regulations in all of its projects in order to help protect employees and beneficiaries from infection. This was done through the following activities:

- 1- Providing personal protective equipment for employees working in all static and mobile clinics. These materials included face masks, gowns, gloves and other requirements, in addition to disinfectants and sterilization materials.
- 2- Complete sterilization of all health facilities with regular provision of sterilization and cleaning solutions and supplies, in order to carry out regular cleaning work on a daily basis.
- 3- Organizing training courses for staff working within the organization's projects in order to orient them about Covid-19 pandemic and its prevention, as well as dealing with the current situation and applying the basic rules in their daily work and activities related to disease prevention.
- 4- Directing all health education and awareness staff in the different camps to focus on raising awareness about the prevention of Covid-19 disease by providing regular sessions for visitors of the health centers, as well as through the household and tent to tent visits to reach the largest possible number of beneficiaries.

2. World Health Organization Representative visiting Heevie projects in Sulaymaniyah

On Thursday, 18/2/2021, Dr. Ahmed Zouiten, the World Health Organization representative in Iraq, with a high delegation from WHO, visited two projects of Heevie Organization in Sulaymaniyah governorate.

In the first station, the aforementioned delegation visited Heevie clinic at Ashti IDP camp in Sulaymaniyah, and were oriented closely about the services provided to the IDPs living in the camp.

Then the delegation, with Dr. Sabah Hawrami, Director-General of Health in Sulaymaniyah Governorate, visited Sulaymaniyah Burns and Plastic Surgery Hospital, where Heevie organization did a complete renovation with expansion for its surgical operation rooms, which has been done with the best materials and highest quality materials.

During these visits, the representative of the World Health Organization expressed his satisfaction and happiness with the various services provided by Heevie, he also highly evaluated Heevie Organization role in providing health services to the host community populations, as well as the IDPs and refugees in the region, and he promised to continue WHO support for the health sector in the region.

3. World Health Organization and Heevie Organization signing four agreements

In a special ceremony in the presence of the World Health Organization representative in Iraq, Dr. Ahmed Zouiten, and Miss. Bakhshan Ali Aziz, Heevie Organization Manager in Duhok, and in the framework of providing and developing the health care services in the region, especially those related to health services provided to the IDPs and refugees, on Monday, 22/2/2021, Heevie and the WHO signed four agreements, aiming to strengthen and improve these services in Duhok, Erbil and Sulaimaniyah governorates. The agreements covered the fields mentioned below:

- Providing physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation services through Heevie specialized center in Dohuk governorate
- Providing primary health care services in five IDPs camps in Dohuk governorate, involving Shariya, Kabarto2, Mam Rshan, Bersivy1 and Rwanga (Qadiya) camps, through Heevie PHCCs in those camps.
- Providing primary health care services in Hasan Sham U2 IDPs camp in Erbil governorate
- Providing primary health care services in Ashti IDPs camp in Sulaymaniyah governorate
- Providing specialized mental health care services in six IDPs camps in Dohuk governorate
- Providing specialized mental health care services in Kalak sub-district and Debaga IDPs camp in Erbil governorate



1. WHO representative in Iraq visiting Heevie projects in Duhok governorate

On Monday, 22/2/2021, and as a continuation of his field visits to health projects in the region, Dr. Ahmed Zouiten, the World Health Organization representative in Iraq, heading a high delegation from WHO, and with Dr. Afrasiab Musa, Director General of Health in Dohuk Governorate, visited Heevie Center for Physiotherapy and Medical Rehabilitation in Dohuk governorate, to closely observe the services that are provided there.

This was followed by a field visit to Heevie PHCC in Shariya IDPs camp, during which he had a short walk between its different departments. During his visit, the World Health Organization representative expressed his happiness for the level of services provided by the Heevie and highly appreciated its role in providing the health care services to the vulnerable populations from IDPs, refugees and host community. To be mentioned that both above projects are implemented by Heevie by the support of WHO.

2. The Deputy Principal Officer at US Consulate at Erbil in a visit to Heevie PHCC at Shariya IDPs camp

On Wednesday, May 19, 2021, Katie Kiser, the Deputy Principal Officer at US Consulate at Erbil, visited the primary healthcare center of Heevie Organization at Shariya IDPs camp in Duhok governorate.

During her visit, Mrs. Kiser got aware of the health services Heevie providing for the displaced people in the camp and conveyed her thank to Heevie Organization, the UN agencies, the international and local NGOs for their work to receive and support the large numbers of IDPs living in the Kurdistan Region of Iraq.

To be mentioned that Dr. Wael Hatahit, heading a delegation from WHO that are supporting Heevie organization, has also attended the event.



3. Training and capacity building of the medical staff

The updates and development in the medical field are progressed in an accelerating manner with continuous renewal, in addition to the continuous challenges faced daily by the medical staff and the health community in the world. In this field, and in order to give the opportunity for the medical staff involved in Heevie projects so as to be aware of the latest updates in the medical field, Heevie Organization is continuous in organizing training courses on a continuous basis covering various topics that are beneficial for the trained staff and also for the sake of the public health issues.



4. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie/Farmamundi specialized health center at Cham Mishko IDP camp in Duhok governorate

As a continuation for the efforts to provide the best healthcare services to the IDPs within the different camp locations, and within the framework of the constant endeavor to fill the gaps in these services in various locations, Heevie Organization, in cooperation with the Farmamundi Spanish organization, started a new project to provide quality health services in Cham Mishko IDPs camp in Zakho district of Dohuk governorate. The camp is the largest in the Dohuk governorate, with a capacity of about 26,000 people, and it is currently inhabited by more than 22,000 displaced people. The project has preceded by establishing a specialized medical and health center in the camp, an activity which will be performed by Heevie engineering department, with joint support from both Heevie and Farmamund. The new center includes rooms for clinical examination in addition to ultrasound, dental, laboratory, pharmacy, psychosocial support, health awareness and other branches and department the center. The center began providing health services as planned since May 1st, 2021, by the support of the Spanish Agency for International Development Cooperation AECID and will continue to provide health services to Cham Mishku for a period of one year with possibility of extension. The number of patients who received treatment during the month of May 2021 reached **(2,122)** patients

5. Heevie response and intervention after Shariya IDPs camp fire accident

On Friday, 4th of June 2021, a big fire accident took place section B of Shariya IDPs camp in Semel district of Duhok governorate. The fire destroyed about 300 tents, affecting an overall number of 187 families. The fire was controlled in hours and there were no serious casualties among the affected people other than 4 burn injuries, three of them were treated easily, and one needed special attention as the injury was in the face region.

The affected people were moved to two new locations to be settled temporarily until new solutions will be found, one was a kindergarten inside the camp, in which 15 families were settled, and the other one was a community center inside the nearby Shariya town. Other families moved to live with other families inside the camp and others with the host community.



HEEVIE INTERVENTION

As a health partner providing the 24/7 healthcare services in the camp, by the support of WHO, and with the initial few minutes of the accident, Heevie teams arrived immediately to the location to provide the necessary assistance and to treat and manage any possible casualties. The intervention was done in multiple steps, as described below:

A. Immediate steps

As an initial response to the accident, Heevie moved a medical team with an ambulance vehicle near the fire location in order to deal with any emergency cases either through immediate management on the field or moving to Heevie clinic inside the camp. From the four injured people, three had simple burn injuries, received the necessary treatment, and one was taken as a serious condition as his injury was in the face. Dressing was done for the wound in the field, and the next day the patient was referred to Duhok Burn and Plastic Surgery Hospital and later on to the Dermatology department in Azadi General Hospital through direct coordination with the head of the department.



B. Supporting the locations specified for the affected people

Two locations were specified for the affected population to be settled in temporary, the kindergarten inside the camp and a community center in Shariya town, around two kilometers distance from the camp. In order to provide the people with the healthcare services, Heevie allocated two medical teams to stabilize them in each of the two locations, each team consisted of a medical doctor, a clinical nurse, a health promoter and an assistant pharmacist.

The team specified for the community center attended the location daily from 8:00 to the midnight, and the one determined for the kindergarten location existed daily in the location in two time period, from 8:00 – 14:00, and from 16:00 – 20:00, the patient were later on treated by Heevie PHCC in the camp. When the patients from both temporary locations were moved to new tents inside the camp, Heevie located a team in one of the tents to receive the patients mainly during the morning hours, and in the remaining time the patients had the opportunity to seek the services in heevie clinic in the camp.

From the beginning of the event till the time this report was prepared, Heevie teams were so far able to treat and manage:

- Total number of patients treated: 334
- Male above 5 years: 70
- Female above 5 years: 153
- Male below five years: 53
- Female below 5 years: 58



C- Health awareness and promotion

Heevie health promotion teams visited the two locations regularly in order to deliver the necessary health awareness messages, paying more attention to the health subjects related to the common conditions and diseases in such situations like the personal hygiene, diarrheal diseases, dermatological diseases and upper respiratory tract infections.



D. Psychosocial Support services

As a part of the support provided for the affected population, and getting the opportunity from Heevie specialized MHPSS center in Shariya camp, Heevie provided the necessary psychosocial support through regular visits from the teams with interviews with the people in the field.



E. Providing the Personal Protection Equipment

Due to the special conditions resulted from the COVID-19 pandemic and in order to prevent the diseases transmission between the affected population, Heevie teams distributed the Personal Protection Equipment among them, like the surgical masks, the gloves and the sterilizing and disinfection solutions.



F. Coordination with the different parties

From the early beginning of the accident, WHO area coordinator in Duhok governorate was in direct contact with Heevie to teams to assure the on-time provision of the services for the affected population and avoid any gap in this regard. The coordination was continuous with the directorate of health in Duhok governorate and the camp management to coordinate the activities and respond to the different needs of the population. As a result of the coordination and cooperation between the different parties, multiple decisions were taken in order to better control the situation and avoid the spread of the communicable diseases, multiple decisions were taken, involving the below actions:

- 1- Taking random PCR samples from selected number of the affected population each day as screening for the COVID-19 infection, and thankfully no cases was recorded among the affected population.
- 2- Strict follow up and management of the cases with the gastrointestinal and diarrheal diseases, in this regard the decision was made to take more V.C samples from the patients covering 100% diarrheal cases.
- 3- Coordinating with the Directorate of Environment in Duhok governorate to perform more frequent examination for the drinking water in the two locations gathering the affected population.
- 4- Better coordination between Heevie and DoH Duhok for the optimum management of the patients, especially in the community center in Shariya town, in regard to the medical treatment, admissions and referrals to the higher health facilities.
- 5- Assuring the safety of the space, the health situation, the safe storage and distribution of the food, the waste management, the WASH services, the protection regulations... etc



6. A fire accident at Ashti IDPs camp in Sulaymaniyah Governorate

On Thursday, 22/7/2021, a fire accident in Ashti IDPs camp in Sulaymaniyah governorate resulted in destruction of four tents. These tents were occupied by three families, and in order to deal with any unexpected health issues, Heevie medical teams attended the fire location in order to provide the necessary assistance and support for any potential cases. Unfortunately, a five-year-old child has fallen victim to the fire, while no other cases have been recorded.



7. A delegation from the European Commission visiting Heevie projects of Physical Rehabilitation and Shariya camp clinic

On Monday, 26/7/2021, a delegation from the European Commission, represented by Miss. Lisa Monaghan, accompanied by World Health Organization area coordinator in Duhok governorate, had a field visit to Heevie Center of Physiotherapy and Medical Rehabilitation in Semel district of Duhok governorate. During the visit, the delegation listened to a brief about the daily activities of the center and had short interviews with the working staff and the beneficiaries. The visiting delegation expressed their high appreciation for what Heevie offers through its project, and also for its adherence to higher standards in providing the best health services to the beneficiary population.

Then, the aforementioned delegation visited the Heevie static clinic at Shariya IDPs camp, located in Semel district, where Heevie organization provides the full package of primary health care services for the displaced population in the camp. During the visit, the delegation was briefed about the different services provided within the center.



8. Supporting the local health facilities

As a result of the continuous crises in the region along with the limited financial resources and also the huge pressure on the health sector, the local health facilities are finding major obstacles and difficulties in its trial to optimally respond to the needs of the beneficiary populations from the host community, IDPs and refugees. As part of Heevie efforts to help fill potential gaps in relation to medicines and medical supplies in these facilities, the organization regularly donates various quantities of medications and medical supplies to different hospitals and health centers belonging to the directorates of health in the different governorates.



9. Establishing Galavezh Center Pediatrics Oncological Diseases in Duhok Governorate

As a part of its activities to support the local healthcare system, Heevie Organization is implementing a project involving extension of Heevi Pediatrics Hospital and establishing a specialized center (Galavezh Center) for Pediatrics Oncological Diseases. The center has the capacity of around 50 beds and will include the following units:

- Inpatient wards with capacity of 25 beds
- Daily patients' management and treatment ward with capacity of 25 beds
- Patient consultation rooms
- Medical procedures unit
- Pharmacy and drug preparation unit
- Administration and filing and archiving unit

The new center will be supported with the oxygen and medical gas system and will be established taking in consideration the highest medical engineering standards. The project involves establishing (Heevi Hospital Endoscopy Unit), which will supported with the required systems and equipment to undergo the required tasks. The total budget specified for the project is 440,560 USD and is estimated to be finalized in 210 working days.



10. Visit of the Consul General of Italy in Erbil to Heevie office in Duhok

On Monday, November 15th, 2021, Mr. (Michele Camerota), the Consul General of Italy in Erbil/Kurdistan Region, visited Heevie office in Duhok. During the visit, a meeting was held to discuss the various activities implemented by Heevie organization and the future plans of the organization in the health and humanitarian field. Then, a brief presentation was provided by Heevie summarizing the different projects of the Organization. His Excellency, the Consul General, expressed his appreciation for all what Heevie is providing and showed his readiness to do whatever necessary from their side to provide the needed support for the organization in order to facilitate the different issues.



11.A special training course on Computer Science for the blind people

As part of its activities to support the people with disabilities and special needs in order to help them adapt the life conditions and to improve their performance and daily activities, Heevie Organization has started conducting a special course on learning the computer programs for the blind people and those with critical vision impairment. The course includes letting the participants be oriented about how to use Windows programs with the NVDA screen reader that has been specifically developed for the blind, in order to enable them to use the computer efficiently, and to deal with the operating system and basic programs smoothly and successfully.

This activity has started on Monday, November 22nd 2021 at Heevie Physiotherapy and Medical Rehabilitation Center and will continue for ten days. The first group of the participants included six blind people, who will be given intensive theoretical and practical lessons during the specified period of the course.



12.A delegation from the European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations visiting Heevie Projects

On Tuesday November 30th 2021, a delegation from the European Commission for Humanitarian Operations visited Heevie Health Care Facility at Hasan Sham U2 camp in Al-Hamdaniyah District of Ninewa Governorate. The purpose of the visit was to get oriented about the services provided within the facility for the camp population who are from the people displaced from Ninewa governor, and also evaluating the situation of the IDPs and their different needs. The visiting delegation was given a brief about the activities implemented by Heevie organization and different aspects of the service provision.
