



Heevie Annual Report for 2018





Activities of the year 2018

Through its wide range of projects implemented during the year 2018, Heevie Organization was able to respond to the health needs of (313,647) patients. These projects covered multiple locations in various areas throughout both Ninewa and Duhok governorates involving the crisis and war affected areas.

The services provided were on the primary, secondary and tertiary health care levels. The primary health care services provided involved clinical examination, medical treatment, reproductive health services, nutrition, vaccination, dental, laboratory, ultrasound, minor surgeries, health education and promotion and referral services to the secondary and higher health care centers.

The secondary and tertiary services involved treating children with congenital heart diseases, supporting DOH facilities and capacity building and training for the local medical staff in cooperation with Italian partners and organizations.

1. Treating Patients and Training the Local Medical staff in cooperation with Italian organizations

Since the year 2006, Heevie organization, and in coordination with the Italian hospitals, centers and organizations, is performing a regular program for providing the necessary medical assistance and treatment for children with various diseases and organ malformations through the surgical intervention and other treatment and management modalities.

The treated cases involved children with congenital heart diseases, renal and genital systems malformations, malignancies, blood disorders and others.

When the program started, Heevie organization, by the support of the KRI government and in coordination with the Italian partners, Heevie sent hundreds of children with various medical and surgical problems to Italy to be treated both medically and surgically according to the need. After establishment of the local health infrastructure in a way being ready to support the program activities, specialized Italian teams started to visit KRI according to a regular schedule, usually, a minimum of 4 missions/ year were performed during which more than 200 operations were done (50 operations per each mission).

The last crises and security instability in Iraq made the Italian teams unable to visit the country; as a solution for that and instead, Heevie used to collect the most acute patients and send them to Italy for operations.

Total number of patients underwent surgical interventions in Italy during the year 2018 are **17** patients. Efforts are ongoing by Heevie to resume the program in Iraq through regulating new missions for the Italian teams.

While implementing the project, Heevie got benefit from the specialized Italian teams during their regular visits to the region to do capacity building for the local staff involving them in the overall all steps of the program and management steps and procedures. This involved training the staff on preparation of the patients for the surgical operations, post operative follow up and care, ICU monitoring, treatment of complications and performing various medical and surgical procedures. The program also involved training of the doctors (mainly pediatricians) on Echocardiography examination for the patients with congenital heart diseases in Italy.

The project of treating patients and training the local medical staff was implemented by the support of many partners and donors especially the Italian organizations, hospitals and centers, American embassy at Baghdad and other donors.

2. Project: Registering and examining the Congenital Heart Diseases Children in Kurdistan Region

Due to the large number of the children complaining from heart diseases, Heevie in cooperation with SIA Italian NGO took the initiative to build up and establish a data base for the patients Congenital Heart Diseases in KRI. The program of collecting examining, registering and documenting the children with congenital heart diseases is one of the first and most active Heevie programs. Heevie Organization is doing a regular documentation for all the possible cases of congenital heart diseases to make their information ready and available if any treatment or intervention modality required. The program involves training of the doctors (mainly pediatricians) on Echocardiography examination for the patients with congenital heart diseases in Italy, in addition to providing Echocardiography machines for the main hospitals and centers in Duhok, Erbil and Sulaymaniyah. During 2018, Heevie has so far registered **391** cases of children with congenital heart diseases within its data base.

3. Project: Mobile Medical Clinics 1&2

Heevie organization has obtained the necessary expert and experience in running mobile medical clinics through dealing with them for the last 16 years; this long period had led to accumulation of expertise among Heevie administrative and medical staff. From the early beginning of the project, Heevie mobile clinics were covering the far-away villages and districts lacking the health facilities, after the events of the year 2014 and the subsequent wars and crises in the region, Heevie directed its MMUs to serve the vulnerable populations from IDPs, returnees and host communities in the conflict affected regions. This involved providing the primary health care services to various camp and non-camp locations in coordination DOH Duhok DOH Ninewa, health sub-clusters and the humanitarian actors in the region.


Heevie Mobile Medical Clinic 1 is covering locations within Duhok and Ninewa, while Mobile Medical Clinic 2 is covering locations in both Tilkef and Bashiqa districts. Both mobile clinics are performing their activities by the support of WHO and DOH Duhok.



4. Project: Community Health Houses

Lack of health facilities in the majority of villages and small towns deprived the community from the minimum coverage by the primary health care services. The inadequate financial resources, shortage of the medical staff and non availability of medications and medical equipment are of the main reason behind this.

Heevie started a wide assessment process for the region aiming to build up a strong skeleton of health facilities being able to fill the existing gap in the health service provision in the region. Here came the idea of establishing the “Community Health Houses”. The project was started by putting prefab buildings and doing the necessary rehabilitation and renovation of others in more than 16 villages in Ninewa governorate. The next step of the project was recruiting the medical staff and procuring the necessary medication and medical equipment and supplies for these facilities. The staff is selected mostly from the same locations after the necessary training was performed.

During the last two years, the list of the villages supported have shown some changes due to the events in the region, the overall villages served during the different time periods of the projects reached around 18 locations to settle finally with 13 villages.

The project of Community Health Houses is implemented by the support of WHO in coordination with DOH Duhok. By now, it is serving more than 25,430 people in 13 villages and towns, during the years 2018, about **57,985** patients have received the treatment within the project.

Heevie organization has provided on the site curative health services in 13 villages with CHH project during 2018, including: Masaka, Kalhe, Shebana, Ein Jheshiya, Tal Musa, Aliyouka, Che Khire, Sahal Hamad, Tal Khidher, Kubane, Derstone, Tal Adas and Badrike villages in Talaafar and Tilkef Districts.

5. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Mam Rash IDP camp

Mam Rash IDPs camp in Shekhan district of Ninewa was established originally to gather the IDPs habiting the non- camp locations and unfinished buildings throughout Duhok governorate. From the first day the camp was ready to receive the IDPs, Heevie established its static PHCC to provide them the necessary primary health care services.

The clinic is performing multiple health programs to let the clinic beneficiaries have an easy, safe and free access to the health care service and minimize the need to seek the services elsewhere since the camp is far from the main districts and it is difficult for the its population to travel to the secondary facilities, by this, Heevie is decreasing the load on these facilities also.

By now, the camp clinic is serving more than 8,362 IDPs as direct beneficiaries in addition to many others from the villages surrounding the camp.

The project implementation has been passed through multiple phases and time periods according to the donors. The first 3 months of the year 2018 was supported by GIZ, during this period **17,973** patients have visited the clinic and received various treatments and interventions.

6. Project: Improving access to comprehensive primary health care services through supporting Aski Mosul, Tal Musa and Hedhayma health facilities in Ninewa Governorate

After liberation of many areas in the northern Ninewa regions from the under ISIS control, the provision of primary care services was an issue of concern for the local authorities and for the humanitarian community as well, especially that these regions have shown a process of return for many of its displaced people, and at the same time it has provided a safe destination for the people escaping from crises and conflict-affected areas near to the region.

Heevie selected three of the main PHCCs in Zummar district to support within its plan for the year 2017 which was extended to 2018, which are Aski Mosul, Hedhayma and Tal Musa PHCCs. The project included expansion in the service provision to involve the full package of services in the 3 locations in addition to adding the required staff from doctors and medical staff to perform the required activities.

This project was implemented by the support of UNOCHA and provided the health care services for more than 30,000 populations in the targeted locations. In project period extended to the year 2018, around **(4,245)** patients got benefit from the services provided and as follows:

7. Project: Supporting Shariya Primary Health Care Center in Semel District in Duhok Governorate

As a continuation for its programs to serve the IDPs in Duhok governorate, Heevie is running the PHCC within Shariya IDPs camp which has the capacity of more than 18,000 populations. Heevie did a valuable progress and development in the health service provision in the camp clinic.

The staff recruited by Heevie involves multiple medical specialties aiming to respond to nearly all the needs of the beneficiaries in the camp, this involved internist, pediatrician, general surgeon, obstetrician, urologist and ENT specialist, in addition to the dental and ultrasound services.

The project implementation has been passed through multiple phases and time periods according to the donors. The first 3 months of the year 2018 was supported by GIZ, during this period **15,178** patients got benefit from the services provided within the camp clinic.



8. Project: Supporting the physiotherapy and the medical rehabilitation activities in Duhok governorate.

During the year 2018, Heevie Organization continued supporting the Medical Rehabilitation activities in Duhok governorate through providing the necessary assistance to the specialized DOH facilities in this regard. This project helped to minimize the load on the exhausted local health facilities which are serving, in addition to the host community, the IDPs and the refugees as well.

The project involves supporting different aspects of Medical Rehabilitation services like training and capacity building of the staff and physiotherapists, extension of service provision hours, provision of raw materials for the prosthetic limbs and renovations and rehabilitation activities of the buildings. The facility of focus in this project is Duhok Specialized Center of Rheumatic Diseases and Medical Rehabilitation which was supported through extending the service provision hours 4 hours/ day, provision of raw materials for the prosthetic limb department and training of the physiotherapist in Italy in coordination with SIA organization from Italy.

The project was further extended to involve community outreach and home visits for the patients with disabilities to provide the necessary physiotherapy sessions, train and educate the family members on the scientific way to deal with their patients, house modification and provision of the necessary assistive devices. The plan of the year 2019 involves providing a special car for transporting the patients with disabilities from their houses to the different health facilities to receive the necessary treatment and interventions.

The project activities were supported by GIZ in the first three months of 2018 and continued by a direct support from Heevie afterwards. During 2018, around **7,919** patients have received physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation and the other services within the project as follows:

9. Project: Primary healthcare service provision through Heevie Static Clinic at Jadaa 3 IDPs camp

The operations for liberating Mosul city led to huge waves of displacement in the region. Many camps were established to receive these IDPs, among which is Jadaa3 camp in Gayyara district which is hosting around 9,000 people mostly from the west bank of Mosul which is nearly totally destructed so the displaced people find difficulties in returning back.

Heevie is responding to the needs of these IDPs through running the camp clinic by providing the primary health care services 24/7.

Heevie Jadaa3 camp clinic project is supported by WHO and during the year 2018, almost **41,823** patients have received the treatment within the clinic.



10. Project: Equitable access to full package primary health care services for IDPs within Heevie static clinics at Shariya, Mam Rash, Kabarto 1 and Kabarto 2 IDPs camps in Duhok and Ninewa governorates.

Duhok governorate is currently hosting more than 660,000 IDPs, from them 340,000 are distributed over 21 camps. The health service provision within these camps is becoming a big challenge for the local health authorities and the humanitarian actors.

To avoid any gap in this regard, it was agreed between Heevie, DOH Duhok and the health cluster that Heevie will run the clinics of four of these camps for the period of four months between April and August 2018.

The camps supported were Shariya, Mam Rash, Kabarto1 and Kabarto2 with a total population of around 52,000. The health service provision in both Shariya and Mam Rash camps was considered a continuation of Heevie already existing activities in both locations while the two camps and Kabarto1 and Kabarto2 were involved due to non-availability of the health service providers.

Heevie took this project as an opportunity to expand the activities and services provided within these centers especially regarding the laboratory, Ultrasound, health promotion and dental services, in addition to adding further medical specialties to respond better to the needs of the beneficiaries.

The project was implemented by the support of UNOCHA and WHO and during the project duration, **(76,796)** patients got benefit from the services provided in the four targeted locations as follows:

11. Project: Equitable access to primary health care services for IDPs within Heevie static clinic at Hassan Sham U2 IDP camp in Ninawa governorate

Heevie Organization continued its efforts to provide the health care services for different groups of vulnerable population in the camps and non camp locations involving the conflict affected region.

In this field, Heevie started its project of providing the primary health care services for the IDPs habiting Hassan Sham U2 camp in Al-Hamdaniya district of Ninewa governorate.

The camp is consisted of 1500 tents and has the capacity of hosting more than 9,000 people. The project is continuous and is implemented by the support of WHO.

Total number of patients got benefit from the services provided within Heevie static clinic at Hassan Sham U2 camp reached **3,307** patients during 2018 as shown in the table below.

12. Project: Primary health care services for IDPs within Heevie static clinic at Mamilyan Camp in Duhok governorates

Mamilyan IDPs camp in Akre district, with capacity of 3300 tents, was established to host the displaced families from Ninewa governorate after the operations for liberating Mosul city from under ISIS control were started.

After the situation was settled and the security situation was stabilized, many of the IDPs have returned back but the camp is still occupied with many families that are in need for the basic life support services including health.

As a response for these needs, Heevie is providing the primary health care services for the displaced families in Mamilyan camp within its static clinic.

The project started late during 2018 by a direct support from Heevie, and the total number of patients got benefit from the services provided from the project services were **953** patients, the break down is shown in the below table.

13. Project: Equitable access to full package primary health care services for IDPs within Heevie static clinics at Shariya and Mam Rash IDP camps in Duhok and Ninewa governorates

The camp locations of Mam Rash and Shariya are hosting more than 30,000 IDPs. Heevie organization is providing the health services in Mam Rash camp since it was first established in 2015, while in Shariya, Heevie clinic is active for the last two years. The organization did its best to assure providing the full package primary health care services in both locations, and for this purpose, Heevie continued coordinating and communicating different partners and donor to keep the high quality service provision in both locations.

The support for both clinics activities passed through different phases according to the donor. During the first three months of 2018, the support was from GIZ, between April and August from WHO and UNOCHA, September and October a direct support from Heevie and WHO resumed its support for the period from November and afterward.

During the year 2018 and for the project period between September and December, **(37,727)** patients got benefit from the services provided in the two targeted locations and as follows:

- The number of consultations in Shariya (18,150)
- The number of consultations in Mam Rash (19,577)

14. Project: Reproductive Health Care Services

Heevie paid the necessary attention for the health of the girls and women and more specifically those of childbearing age.

In this regard, Heevie assured recruiting the female staff from doctors and nurses within all its projects to provide the reproductive health care services including antenatal care, post natal care and family planning. Additional care for the women health was done through performing screening for breast cancer, education about the breast feeding procedures and provision of the tonic medications.

The project activities were implemented by the support of UNFPA and below are statistics of the reproductive health care services provided within Heevie projects for the year 2018:

15. Project: Adoption

Among the constant activities of Heevie Organization is the Adoption program which helps to find financial resources for the children of the poor families in KRI. The project concentrates on building the social relations between Kurdish and the Italian societies. Within this program, Heevie links the fundraisers from Italy, who are interested in donations, to the patient children descending from poor families. During the year 2018, many families received donations for their children from Italy as a part of this program's activities.

16. Project: Health Capacity Building

In an attempt to fill the existing gaps, Heevie Organization, in coordination with SIA Italian Organization, is supporting Duhok General Directorate of Health in a long term program to maintain and improve the necessary resources for provision of the quality health care services in various facilities, hospitals and specialized centers belonging to the directorate.

This program comes after Heevie teams performed the required assessments to determine the shortages and needs existed within different DOH Duhok facilities.

Heevie project is aiming to improve the skills and abilities of the health staff, and also develop and improve the interference mechanisms and the treatment and management protocols within different health facilities according to the below mechanisms:

1. Training and capacity building of the health care service providers from different branches and specialties.
2. Filling the gap regarding the shortage of staff of the health facilities which will be done in coordination with the DOH through various mechanisms to respond to the increasing needs especially of the newly established facilities.
3. Management of patients with congenital anomalies, especially the congenital heart diseases, through providing the required medical care and management in addition to the special surgical treatment for selected cases who are in need for delicate surgical intervention in Italy.

The implementation of this project started early in 2018 through the below mentioned activities:

- 1- Supporting the staff of the Neonatal ICU of Heevi Pediatrics Teaching Hospital and ICU and CCU of Azadi teaching hospital.
- 2- Training courses for 20 physiotherapists in Italy.
- 3- Training courses for the doctors in both Cardiac Catheterization and Vascular Surgery.
- 4- Initiating the process of supporting the Stroke Unit at Azadi Teaching Hospital.
